**2020 Shawan Downs Point to Point
TRAINER PROTOCOL**

1. When you arrive, at the first check point, you will hand in your Health Screening Questionnaire- these MUST be completed prior to arrival. There will be NO questionnaires onsite so if you have forgotten yours, NO ENTRY. NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. Your temperature will be taken. You will be given a wristband which must be put on your wrist immediately and worn throughout the day until you exit the grounds.
3. Upon passing the health screening, you will be presented w/ a wristband which you must wear at all times.
4. If you do not pass the health screening, you and all occupants of your vehicle must leave the property immediately. NO EXCEPTIONS.
5. As mandated per the state and county, Trainers may have no more than themselves in their vehicle unless carpooling w/ other participating horsemen (riders and/or trainers).
6. All Trainers will park in the “Triangle Field” across from the portable office trailer.
7. FACEMASKS MUST BE WORN at ALL TIMES.
8. Trainers may circulate between their vehicle in their van/trailer in the “Stable Area,” their vehicle in the triangle field and the face of Founders Hill for viewing the races.
9. There will be NO ADMITTANCE to the STEWARD STAND.
10. THERE WILL BE NO STANDING AROUND SOCIALIZING.

WE HAVE A VERY LONG DAY AND YOUR COMPLETE AND TOTAL COORPEATION IS A MUST IN ORDER FOR THIS DAY TO RUN SMOOTHLY.

PLEASE REMEMBER:

All Trainers running horses at the Legacy Chase must submit the Trainer’s Grooms List to the NSA Office by 5PM Wednesday, September 23rd in order for their Grooms to enter the property on race day.

All trainers are responsible for sharing the Groom’s Protocol with their grooms and assuring their understanding of and readiness to comply.

NOTE:

Please be advised that we will not provide any drinks, snack, and/or ice. Everyone must bring any and all provisions with them to the property.

There will be no trash receptacles or collection onsite. All attendees must take everything they came with home with them. Thank you.
