**2020 Legacy Chase
JOCKEY/ RIDER PROTOCOL**

1. When you arrive at the first check point you will hand in your Health Screening Questionnaire- these MUST be completed prior to arrival. There will be NO questionnaires onsite so if you have forgotten yours, NO ENTRY. NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. Your temperature will be taken. You will be given a wristband which must be put on your wrist immediately and worn throughout the day until you exit the grounds.
3. Upon passing the health screening, you will be presented w/ a wristband which you must wear at all times.
4. If you do not pass the health screening, you and all occupants of your vehicle must leave the property immediately. NO EXCEPTIONS.
5. As mandated per the state and county, Riders may have no more than themselves in their vehicle unless carpooling w/ other participating horsemen (riders and/or trainers).
6. All jockeys will park in the “Stable Area” next to the barns.
7. FACEMASKS MUST BE WORN at ALL TIMES.
8. When the call for Horses to the Assembly Area is announced, you will proceed to the Assembly Area still wearing your facemask. As your horse arrives, you will get straight on your horse. THERE WILL BE NO STANDING AROUND SOCIALIZING. Once everyone has mounted you will go onto the race course. At this point, the mask may be pulled down. You should proceed directly to the Steward Stand and then carry on to the start.
9. After the race, all horses will come back to the assembly area where their grooms will take them and return them to their van/ trailer.
1. The only exception is the Winner of the race. This horse will remain on the course, the groom will hold onto their horse for the win picture in front of the double gates next to where the horses first enter the course. Afterwards, they will proceed directly to the Assembly Area for dismount and return to the van/ trailer. *Please ensure all masks are up (including the rider, groom, etc.) in the win shots.*
10. Masks MUST be put back on before you dismount.
11. If there is a claim of foul, there will be a designated person in the assembly area with a radio to contact the stewards. You will then weigh in and Vicky Collins, the clerk of scales, will hand you a radio so you can speak w/ the Stewards.
12. If it is necessary to see the Stewards between races, there will be a designated shuttle to take you to the Steward Stand.

WE HAVE A VERY LONG DAY AND YOUR COMPLETE AND TOTAL COORPEATION IS A MUST IN ORDER FOR THIS DAY TO RUN SMOOTHLY.
